All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by a negative Coggins Test Certificate issued within the past twelve (12) months, proof of an EHV-1 vaccination within six (6) months, a Health Certificate issued within ten (10) days prior to the date of arrival to Running Aces. The original Coggins Test Certificate is required by the MRC. No Exceptions.

2019 POLICIES & REGULATIONS

1. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
2. In considering stall applications that are of substantially equal merit, the association shall give preference to horses owned by Minnesota residents.
3. Once approved to race at Running Aces trainers will pay a service fee of \$120 / month / horse for stall service fees arranged by separate contract with the track. This service fee will cover manure removal, water and other backside operational costs.
4. Positively NO DOGS are permitted in the stabling area.
5. No bedding other than straw or shavings permitted without prior approval.
6. The applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the Minnesota Racing Commission (MRC), Running Aces Casino & Racetrack (Running Aces) and the designated organization representing the majority of horsemen; and accept the decision of the Judges as final on matters pertaining to racing except as appeals are permitted under specific rules of the MRC.
7. The applicant agrees to abide by the rules established by the Rules and Enforcement Committee.
8. The MRC requires all owners, trainers and drivers to be licensed before they can start a horse.
9. The Laws of Minnesota require all persons under 16 years of age must possess working papers (birth certificate must be produced to secure such working papers). Minnesota Rules of Racing requires "no person will be considered for or granted work under 16 years of age."
10. Firearms are absolutely prohibited on the premises at all times.
11. Heating appliances of any kind, including heating lamps, are not permitted on the premises.
12. No sleeping or cooking in tack rooms is permitted. Cooking must be done outdoors and away from the barns.
13. No person may consume alcoholic beverages on the backstretch on a race day before they will be in the paddock participating in the program in any capacity. All licensees are subject to sobriety tests at ALL times on the backstretch. Intoxication will not be tolerated.
14. When using the race track, all drivers, trainers and grooms are required to wear safety helmets while on the race track.
15. All horses must be tattooed or freeze branded before starting. If any doubt arises as to the identify of any horse, said horse must be relocated immediately.
16. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by a negative Coggins Test Certificate issued within the past twelve (12) months, proof of an EHV-1 vaccination within six (6) months, a Health Certificate issued within ten (10) days prior to the date of arrival to Running Aces. The original Coggins Test Certificate is required by the MRC.
17. Horsemen will be allocated stalls with the understanding that their horses are ready to race. Running Aces reserves the right to ask horsemen to leave the property after a period of inactivity, if they do not enter their horses in races that are available.
18. **Prior approval must be obtained from the Racing Secretary for any trainer requesting additional stall space for any horse or horses purchased through private sales, claims or trainer transfers. This must be done before and NOT after, to receive any consideration.**
19. All applicants will cooperate with the Racing Secretary in the moving of horses in order to utilize the stabling facilities to the fullest extent.
20. **Each trainer shall register with the Racing Secretary all horses in his charge giving the name, age, sex, breeding and ownership of each within 24 hours of arrival. Any horse stabled on the grounds of the association without having been so registered or occupying a stall not assigned to him unless by special permission, will be cause for disciplinary action.**
21. At the discretion of the Judges or Running Aces and without notice, the entries of any person or transfer of any horse to a new trainer may be refused.
22. Running Aces reserves the right to refuse any entry based upon poor performance.
23. Owners and trainers will be held responsible for the conduct of their employees while on the premises. All trainers and their employees must be fingerprinted and shall at all times have their picture ID Badges visibly displayed in all restricted areas, including while in the Test Barn. Failure to comply shall result in a hearing with potential of a fine and suspension.
24. It is hereby agreed that Running Aces shall NOT be liable for and that the owner and/or lessees of the horse will indemnify and hold harmless Running Aces against all responsibility, liability or claim of injury or damage to any person, horse or other property of the undersigned, or of any other person, or his or their agents, employees or associates, caused by the horse, or agent of the employees of the undersigned, or by any other person, including employees, agents of Running Aces whether by negligence or otherwise, on the premises of Running Aces.
25. All trainers shall carry compensation insurance covering all of their employees in accordance with MRC rules.
26. A Certificate of Worker's Comp must be on file with the MRC.
27. Trainers, and owners(s), hereby expressly undertake to indemnify Running Aces by written contract in accordance with Section 303 (b) of the Workers Compensation Act.
28. All areas on the restricted backstretch will be subject to inspection by management or MRC. All areas are to be raked and cleaned daily. Trainers are responsible upon departure for leaving their stalls and stabling area in the same condition as they found it including stall matting.
29. Any horse which has not raced for a period of forty-five (45) days must qualify before they are allowed to start.
30. Running Aces may televise or authorize the televising of horse racing and to conduct pari-mutuel wagering thereon pursuant to the MRC, as amended, and the rules and regulations there under as well as the Interstate Horse Racing Act of 1978, as amended.
31. If any applicant has in his charge any horse whose name appears on any barred list (veterinarian, start, judge's or any other barred list at any track) such applicant shall report the name of such horses and the fact that he has been so barred to the Racing Secretary at any meeting within Minnesota at which he proposes to enter such horse to race.
32. As the organizer, host and sponsor of Standardbred horse racing at this facility, Running Aces reserves unto itself, its agents, assign and licenses the sole and exclusive right to produce, exhibit, perform, transmit, license or sell in any manner still or motion pictures, radio and television broadcasts, or any other media transmission now known or hereafter developed of all activities occurring prior to, during and after Standardbred horse races; the sole and exclusive right to use each race and the results thereof for any purpose as Running Aces shall determine. This grant of rights includes all worldwide copyright in perpetuity in and to each race at Running Aces in which Trainers, Owners, and their employees and agents participate. The acceptance of stall accommodations, the submission of a nomination or the making of any entry in any race shall mean that the trainer on behalf of him/herself, his owners, and his and their employees and agents, consents to the reservation of right by Running Aces and consents to be photographed or otherwise by subject of still or moving pictures in all media, radio or television programs, without payment except for those contributions to horsemen's purses as agreed in the applicable Live Racing Agreement with the horsemen's representative group. The trainer on behalf of him/herself, his owners, and his and their employees and agents agrees that he/she has not and will not take any action which would cause an assignment or transfers of any rights contemplated herein, or assert any claim, demand, or cause of action against Running Aces of these rights.
33. All changes in trainers must be reported to the MRC and the Racing Secretary immediately along with the owner's and previous trainer's authorization.
34. Running Aces reserves the right to decline stall space to any owner or trainer. The removal of any dead horse is at the expense of the owner and under MRC Rules a necropsy must be performed.
35. Running Aces also reserves the right to refuse admittance to or reject anyone whose presence it considers not to be in the best interest of racing (undesirable) in accordance with regulations of the MRC.
36. The applicant releases Running Aces from and waives any and all claims for injury personally suffered by the applicant while on the premises; and assumes the risk, and releases and waives against Running Aces for any and all claims for loss of use, injury or damage to horses owned or under the control of the applicant or the applicant's invites incurred while on any Running Aces' property.
37. Applicant is responsible for the conduct of each, and every employee and/or any person or persons under his charge or control, or any person, firm or corporation, contracting with the applicant on the premises, and to all persons granted a pass at the applicant's request.
38. Track Hours are 7AM—12PM daily with the exception of Wednesdays. Applicants are expected to utilize the racetrack for training. No horses may be jogged around the barns when the track is open for training.
39. Absolutely NO PONYING or leading of horses at any time while on the premises.
40. **For the 2019 Racing Season, Running Aces will require a minimum of 7 betting entries in races that are not restricted.**

**All Stalls MUST BE STRIPPED before departing!
A \$25.00 fee will be assessed for each stall vacated and not cleaned.**

In making this application to participate in Standardbred racing, and entering application for stalls, it is understood that an investigative report may be made whereby information is obtained through personal interviews with third parties, such as family members, business associates, financial sources, friends, neighbors or other with whom you are acquainted. This includes information as to applicant's character, general reputation, personal characteristics and mode of living, which may be applicable. Applicant has the right to make a written request within a reasonable time period for a complete and accurate disclosure of additional information concerning the nature and scope of this investigation.

The applicant will not mutilate or in any way damage the accommodations allotted to the applicant and that the applicant will not make or permit any structural or electrical changes in the stabling accommodations, that the applicant will be responsible for all damages to the stabling accommodations allotted to the applicant while the horse, or any of them, are stabled therein. The applicant further agrees to keep such stable accommodation in clean and good condition and deposit manure and litter where and in the manner directed by Running Aces.
